

# S. Y. JOSEPHS CO. IS INCORPORATED

New \$50,000 Corporation to Oper-  
ate the "Boston Store"  
Business.

MADISON, Wis., Aug. 24.—Articles of incorporation for the "S. Y. Josephs company" of Superior have been filed with the secretary of state. The capital stock of the company is fixed at \$50,000, divided into 500 shares of a par value of \$100 each. The incorporators are: S. Y. Josephs, L. M. Shapiro and H. C. Wilson, all of Superior.

S. Y. Josephs of the new company was located last night just as he was preparing to take a train for St. Paul on business in connection with the incorporation of the company and, while he confirmed the dispatch, he did not have time to discuss the plans.

It is understood that the new company will continue the Boston store business at the present stand, 1306-1308 Tower avenue, but that extensive improvements will be made, not only in the building, but in the general arrangement of the stock, and that additional departments will be operated. Now the store carries principally ladies' ready-to-wear goods, but with the additions the goods usually found in department stores will be offered.

Since it was opened by S. Y. Josephs several years ago the Boston store's business has shown a steady increase, and it is to meet this, it is understood, that the company is incorporated and enlarged. Mr. Shapiro, as well as Mr. Josephs, will give his entire time to assisting in the management of the store. The change is effective Sept. 1.
