

HEBREW REPUBLICANS.

They organize the first club of the kind
in the County

At a meeting held at the Republican
headquarters yesterday, M. I. Levin
organized a Hebrew Republican club.
The following officers were elected:
President, D. Silk; vice president, M.
Zalk; chairman, H. Yosefovitz; secretary,
M. Leo Levin. Mr. Levin delivered an
address, in which, describing the miser-
able condition of Russia and other Euro-
pean countries, he said, that a free
country like that of the United States
cannot be understood as such by those
persons who still brag about the old
country rotten ideals. Speaking about
protection and free trade, he clearly
pointed out that protection was a blessing
to American industries and work-
ingmen. Free trade could not benefit
America while in other countries it made
workingmen the slaves of hunger,
starvation and militarism. He is an
American in the true sense and he is an
honest voter, and a foreigner will get
along in this country.
