

ST. LOUIS HOTEL ASSETS SOLD.

Assignee of the Old Company Closes Out Its Possessions.

Assignee C. A. Wright, of the old St. Louis Hotel company, yesterday disposed of the last of the assets at public auction in the hotel rotunda. Among the assets were 500 shares of Pennsylvania Iron company stock, 100 shares of Carnegie Iron company stock, 600 shares of Licking Iron company stock, 100 shares of Minneapolis Iron company stock, 505 shares of Northern Light Iron company stock, 50 shares Columbus Iron company stock.

The entire list of iron stock went for the sum of \$2 to Charles A. Phelps. A watch was bid in by Charles Maginnis for \$30, and the book accounts were knocked down to Samuel Loeb on the sixty-fifth bid for \$131. A quarter section of land in Douglas county, Wis., sold for \$105 to I. Freimuth. A number of lots and subdivisions of blocks in Superior sold for \$1. the purchaser, Samuel Loeb, assuming mortgages to the amount of \$6,255.

Parcels of land and lots in St. Louis county were sold on the same basis, the purchasers assuming taxes or mortgages, or both. The total receipts of the sale were \$276.
