## YOM KIPPUR, OR HEBREW'S DAY OF FASTING, THIS WEEK

Temple Emanuel to Celebrate the Event By Ceremonies on Wednesday Evening and on Thursday Morning—Very Elaborate Musical Program Arranged Under Direction of Miss McKay.

On Wednesday evening next will begin the Jewish day of atonement, or Yom Kippur, which is considered by all Hebrews the most important holiday of the year. It is a day of fasting and continues from sunset to sunset. On that evening the Temple Emanuel will hold services at the Unitarian church and the musical program, which has been arranged by Miss Susanne McKay, will be even more elaborate than that of the Jewish new year, which was celebrated recently. Services will begin at 7:30 sharp on Wednesday evening and at 9:30 on Thursday morning. The latter service will last until night with an intermission of about two hours—from noon until 2 o'clock.
