Next Year.

MANY CHANGES MADE

In the Annual Report of the Committee

Which Will be Adopted Upon by the Board of Education This Evening.

For the first time in the history of the board of education the schedule of teachers to be employed in the city schools was obtained today before the June meeting at which the list is usually adopted. It is now made public for the first time and is exactly as it was finally approved at the all-day session of some of the board members and the superintendent Saturday and as it is being printed today for presentation this evening at the board session. Changes have been made in every school and the majority of the teachers will find that they have been appointed to new positions.

The showing of the list is that throughout the High schools and in every ward school there have been raises in salaries with the idea in view of retaining in Grand Rapids the present efficient staff of instructors and teachers. The task of the committee on teachers, of which Trustee Corwin is the chairman, and which is now finished, has occupied three months and has required within the last month meetings three, four and five times each week. The applications from the outside footed up in the hundreds while for the first time in years the committee was confronted with applications for reappointment from every teacher already employed. Later several, however, withdrew their applications and agreed to take a one year's leave of absence. Besides being of interest to the board members outside of the committee and the teachers and their pupils, the schedule is of great interest to the parents and those generally who have the schools and their work at heart. The appointments carry with them the appropriation of over \$200,000 of the people's money, considerable of which is an increase over last year and previous years.

A new feature for next year will be the installation of a city teacher at the Waterloo Free kindergarten.

The salaries of the ward teachers not principals are fixed by rule, first year cadets receiving \$800, second year cadets \$325; those in their first year in charge of a room from \$850 to \$400 according to height of grade, those in second year from \$400 to \$450, those in third year from \$450 to \$500, those in fourth year from \$500 to \$550, in the fifth year from \$550 to \$600, and those in the sixth year \$575 to \$650.

The report of the committee given here in full will without doubt be adopted entire since the word of the committee is law and it has never been customary to make an alteration in a board meeting. Those trustees particularly interested in certain teachers have been given a hearing and where it has been possible they have been accommodated.
