

# MAYOR ADDRESSES JEWISH VOTERS

More than three hundred Jewish voters of Duluth, with their wives and children gathered last evening in Odd Fellows' hall and participated in one of the most enthusiastic Republican meetings held in the city during the present municipal campaign.

The program of speeches was interspersed with musical numbers. Mayor Hugo came in during the latter part of the evening and gave a short talk that was enthusiastically received.

Several addresses were delivered in the Hebraic language, among the speakers being H. J. Josephs, D. Lugoff C. Weisman and M. Zalk, who were introduced by M. Z. Kassmir, chairman of the meeting. They all touched on the prosperity that Duluth has enjoyed under the Hugo administration and urged that the Republican party be supported in the election today and the coming national campaign.

Ex-Sheriff W. C. Sargent and W. E. Culkin referred to the election today as the opening gun of the presidential election in the fall so far as Duluth is concerned and urged every voter to work toward a Republican victory.

An enjoyable feature of the program was the singing of the Chicago Star

Opera company and several duets by Mr. and Mrs. Weisman. All of the songs were well rendered and the singers were compelled to respond to numerous encores.
