

POLICE SEEK JOB FOR ORPHAN LAD

**Ben Karon, Fifteen Years of Age,
Picked Up When He Asks
for Lodging.**

Ben Karon, 15 years old, an orphan, is detained at the police station pending word from relatives at Minneapolis. The lad was found wandering about the streets early yesterday morning. He accosted a policeman and asked to be furnished with a place to sleep.

Karon claims to have come to this country from Russia eight years ago. Shortly after his arrival here his parents died and up to last spring he lived with a married sister at Minneapolis. The sister, he says, advised him to come to Superior and for several months he was employed at a hat repairing shop. Lack of business, he claims, caused him to lose his job a week ago and his small savings were soon exhausted.

Confinement in a cell does not appeal to the lad and he pleaded all day long to be liberated that he might look for work. The police, however, have taken the matter in hand and will endeavor to get some assurance of a job for the boy before allowing him his freedom and taking chances on his having to wander about without food or shelter.
