
UNKNOWN ASSAILANT ASSAULTS JEWISH RABBI

MINNEAPOLIS, Aug. 21.—Rabbi M. Abrahamson early yesterday was assaulted and beaten by an unknown assailant. The attack occurred near the rabbi's home, the culprit springing from a bunch of weeds that hid him from view until the very instant of striking. The stranger struck the rabbi in the head with a brick, following up with a rain of blows in the face with his fist. When the minister sought to defend himself, the assailant took to his heels, crying "I'll kill you yet."

Rabbi Abrahamson staggered home where he fell unconscious. Restored to consciousness, he reported the attack to the police, giving a description of the man who beat him. While his injuries are painful, they are not serious. The rabbi said he could give no reason for the assault, unless it be that he had been active in an effort to procure the establishment of a Jewish cooperative market in his neighborhood.
