

JEWELRY CLERK UNDER ARREST

**Charged With Alleged Larceny of
Silverware and Other Ar-
ticles From Employer.**

**WAIVES EXAMINATION
IN MUNICIPAL COURT**

**Bail Fixed at \$1,000—Has Pre-
viously Borne Good Repu-
tation in City.**

John A. Borner, clerk in the jewel-ry store of Garon Bros., 213 West First street, was arrested yesterday afternoon by Detective Terry on the charge of grand larceny, preferred against him by his employers. Borner waived examination before Judge Cutting and was bound over to await the action of the grand jury in the sum of \$1,000.

At the time of his arrest it is claimed that a quantity of jewelry and silverware was found on Borner's person. He is charged with having stolen jewelry from the store to the amount of \$132.25, consisting of watches, rings, ear rings, silver plated spoons and gold crosses. The articles were locked up in the safe at the police station.

It is said that Borner, who is a young man, has heretofore borne an excellent reputation for honesty, having been employed at the Erd jewelry store for a long time. He had been working for Garon Bros. but a week.
