Rabbi Lefkovitz was born in Hun-Rabbi Lefkovitz was born in Hun-gary, Feb. 15, 1875, and completed his high school course in that coun-try. He then matriculated at the University of Marburg, later trans-ferring to the University of Rerlin from which he was graduated. While attending the university he studied durium his off hours at the Jewish Theological seminary of Berlin. While still an undergraduate he was awarded first prize in a competition by the University of Berne was awarded first prize in a competi-tion by the University of Berne, Switzerland, the title of his paper be-ing, "The Theory of Government Based on Kant's Philosophy." In 1898 this university conferred upon the rabbi the degree of doctor of

Rev. Swaney A. Nelson, the asso-ciation's president, says that Rabbi Leftkovitz has proven himself a man of such broad convictions and has taken such an interest in the minister-ial work, that the office was unani-mously conferred upon him.

In May 1899, ho came to America and in the following September matriculated at the Hebrew Union college, of Cincinnati, and the University of Cincinnati, in June, 1909, he was graduated as a rabhi and served in that capacity for the Congressition of Monteflore of Lag Vegas, New March forces Centrals. the Co. New Mexico, from September, 1902 till Feburary, 1907. He was then chosen as rabil of the Temple Em-manuel of this city where he has served since that time. served since that time.

Rabhi Lefkovitz specialized while a student in Jewish theology, philosophical student in Jewish theology, philosophical students are student in Jewish theology. He is the authority of the paper which was awarded the prize in Switzerland, and bears the same tittle; the other being "The Philosophy of the Book of Ecclesiates."
