

BOWERY MERCHANT IS ACCUSED OF LARCENY

Froeke Labovitz was arrested yesterday afternoon by Court Officer Jensen, charged with petit larceny. He pleaded not guilty before Judge Windom and his case is set for a hearing this morning at 10 o'clock.

Labovitz is a second hand dealer on the bowery, and is charged with keeping an accordion, said to be the property of Henning Kovikko, contrary to the wishes of the complainant.
