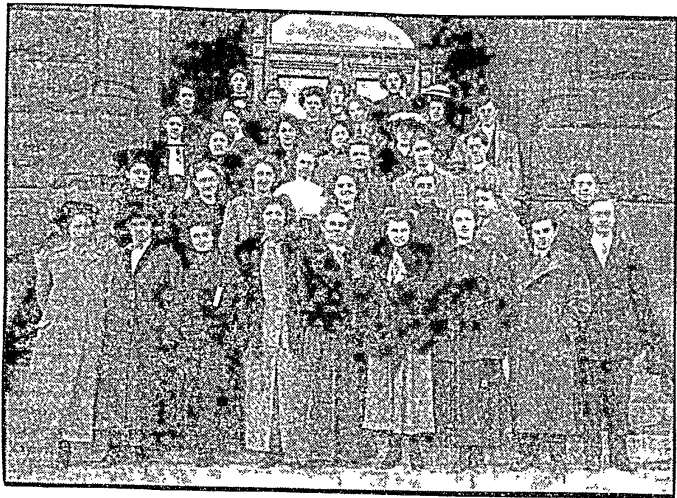


SCHILLERBUND OF CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL
