

PIONEER JEWISH CITIZEN IS DEAD

Arnold Pomush, one of Superior's foremost Jewish citizens and for 22 years proprietor of the Lake Superior Fish company, located at 411 Baxter avenue, died at 7 o'clock last night at St. Mary's hospital after an illness of 10 days. He was removed from his home to the institution but two hours before his death.

The deceased was 50 years of age and leaves a wife and six children. They are Mrs. Rose Kaner, Mrs. Ben Milavitz, Mrs. Lillian Podulsky, Misses Sarah and Elsie and Isadore Pomush. All live in Superior. Mr. Pomish was a devoted friend to charity and gave often and plenty in proportion to his means.
