

ALDERMEN NAME ELECTION JUDGES

Men Who Will Have Charge of
Polling Places at Virginia
Are Selected.

VIRGINIA, Aug. 23.—The judges of election named by the ward aldermen to serve at the primary election Tuesday, Sept. 17, were named last night as follows:

First ward—Chosen by M. Boyland: Henning Erickson, Paul Sevenich and William Rooney; polling place, Virginia hotel.

Second ward—Chosen by William Ketola: Sam Milavetz, August Wahlberg and H. H. Loin; polling place, Virginia Finnish Temperance hall.

Third ward—Chosen by E. J. Moilan: William R. Byrne, Andy Olson and S. A. Pickarine; polling place, Northern hotel.

Fourth ward—Chosen by council: Alderman Keller, being at Mt. Clemens, Mich., taking treatment for rheumatism; C. M. Dorway, H. J. Nathanson and R. W. Wilcox; polling place, City hall building.

Fifth ward—Chosen by A. D. Heritage: J. L. Murkley, C. A. Lucas and F. J. Rinnert; polling place, Mitchell hotel.

Sixth ward—Chosen by George Harvey: A. L. Hearn, A. E. Sorenson and A. W. Hubbard; polling place, Johnson's green house.
