

SYNAGOGUE TO GO UP IN CHISHOLM

Hebrews Have Funds Sufficient
to Justify Contract for
Building.

CHISHOLM, Aug. 27.—Arrangements have advanced to such a stage that the Hebrews of Chisholm will begin the erection of a synagogue in the very near future. A site on the corner of Fourth avenue and Walnut street has been procured and the necessary funds for the erection of the building have been provided for. Plans have been practically decided upon for the general plan and the small details are being worked out.

There is some talk that the Scandinavians will also erect a church on their site purchased last year on the corner of First avenue and Spruce street. These proposed churches would give Chisholm representation for all of the leading nationalities.
