

DULUTH ARCHITECT FOR HIBBING BLOCK

HIBBING, Aug. 4.—E. F. Broomhall, the Duluth architect, will probably prepare the plans for the new three-story business block to be erected by Bryan O'Rourke on Third avenue between Center and Pine streets. It will be occupied by Ben Lippman with a complete department store, some time before the first of next year. It is probable the third floor of the building will be used as a hall for the local lodge of Elks, and some change in the plans made will be necessitated if a contract is entered into with Mr. O'Rourke.
