

GEORGE MULLIGAN WINS HIS SUIT

VIRGINIA, Sept. 20.—In the district court the jury has awarded a verdict of \$206.66 in the case of George W. Mulligan, administrator of the estate of Jennie B. Mulligan against Julius and Morris Shanedling. The complaint charged that the defendants damaged a building adjoining a new one they erected, by going too low with the foundation and weakening it in such a manner that the floors sagged and the walls cracked. The original claim was for \$400. At a former term of the court when the case was ready for trial Jennie B. Mulligan died suddenly. It was continued by her husband as administrator.
