## SITE SECURED FOR HEBREW SCHOOL Purchase Is Celebrated by Over

100 Prominent Jewish Citizens at Adas Israel Synagogue.

Nearly 100 prominent Jewish citizens met last evening at the Adas Israel synagogue, Third avenue East and Third street, to celebrate the purchase of a site for the location of a Hebrew institute, the first of its kind in the city and possibly in the

state. Joseph Oreckowsky, chairman of the committee, which has appointed last month to raise funds for the

project, formally announced that the building at 310 and 312 East Third street, adjoining the synagogue had been bought for the purpose of locating the school there. Rabbis Teplitz and Horwitz, made short addresses in which they com-mented on the action of the committee in selecting this desirable site. Rapbi Teplitz talked from a Talmu'dical standpoint and showed the ur-

gent need of the establishment of such an institution. Rabbi Horwitz, principal of the present Moses Montefiore Hebrew school, expressed himself as pleased with the work of the committee, and dealt with the activities of the school of which he is in charge. Following the meeting and ad-dresses, the ladies of the synagogue

served a banquet in the parlors.

A meeting of the committee charge of securing money for the school, will be held sometime this week. Detailed plans will then be worked out, as, to the campaign for

funds which will be inaugurated

shortly.
