

GIRLS WILL STUDY HEBREW LANGUAGE

Organization Formed for That
Purpose—Will Raise Funds
to Erect School.

Twenty-five Jewish young women met last night at the home of Dr. E. Horwitz, 223 East Third street, for the purpose of organizing a Duluth Young Women's Hebrew association. The object of the organization is to begin the study of the Hebrew language and also to help raise funds for the erection of a Hebrew school which will be known as the Moses Montefiore Hebrew seminary.

Plans for the construction of a building to house the school have already been drawn up. It is practically certain that it will be built at a cost of about \$20,000. All of the prominent orthodox Jews in the city have agreed to support the project and the work of soliciting funds is now going on. Joseph Oreckóvsky is chairman of the committee in charge of collecting the money.

A committee of the young women to help along with the work was also appointed. It consists of the following: Miss Eva Zalk, Miss Esther Sanders, Miss Dolly Polinsky, Miss Mammie Rachlin, Miss Fannie Karon, Miss Matilda Bergson, Miss Rae Zurovsky, and Miss Rose Coran.
