

RANGE NEWSDEALERS IN "JIM-JAM-JEMS" CASE

HIBBING, Jan. 6.—Subpoenas to appear before the grand jury at the coming term of the United States district court in Duluth were this morning served upon Morris Hostetler, Abraham Ritz, M. Garber and C. Norwitz.

The impression prevails here that they are wanted as witnesses to give evidence before the grand jury touching on the sale of Jim Jam Jems on the iron range. The two first named are news dealers.

George V. Chase of Fargo and a United States postoffice inspector from Duluth spent several days about three weeks ago inquiring into the sale of the publication here, securing data at the express offices and otherwise busying themselves.
