



TEST No. 21,146—Water taken at Carmel Dam. Conditions: Gravel bottom, rock sides, no vegetation, no dwellings near.

TEST No. 21,147—Water taken from the margin of Clay Pits Reservoir. TEST No. 21,148—Water taken from center of Clay Pita Reservoir. TEST No. 21.149-Water taken from Carmel River about 100 yards above the dam. TEST No. 21,150-Water taken from Pacific Grove Reservoir, near gate house. TEST No. 21,151-Water taken from tap in school yard at Carmel-by-the-Sea, pumped

All these samples furnished normal results, with reasonable counts and no evidence of B. Coli, indicating a satisfactory condition and the absence of intestinal bacteria due Interpreted, the foregoing indications are that these waters were free from contamination and entirely safe for domestic consumption.
