

No Betting on Results of Series Flashed on Boards

Abrahamson will ask that there be no betting in the house. The ban on gambling is the result of experiences managers have had with the boards in other cities and Mr. Abrahamson will make every effort to eliminate the danger of any betting controversies.

"So tense grows the excitement over the game on the score board at times," says Mr. Abrahamson, "that gambling cannot be tolerated. I have talked to theater managers who had these electric boards in their houses and they found it necessary to place a ban on gambling."
