CHISHOLM, March 9.—The closing days of the campaign for village offices are growing interesting. Until Saturday only one complete ticket was in the field, but last night a meeting of the so-called progressive element was held and a full list of nominations made. S. Sapero was selected as the candidate for village president and those chosen to run on what is known as the "Town" ticket with him, are:

Trustees, Julius Grosso, A. Fjellstadt, Matt Borlin; recorder, Henry Fugere; treasurer, Fred Hurt; assessor, Anton Gerzin.

The other ticket, which also has strong support, is as follows:

President, D. C. Hackett; trustees, William Ritchel, Matt Borlin and J. H. McNiven; recorder, Minty Tramountin; treasurer, Charles French and Fred Hurt, both endorsed. Charles Kimball is running as an independent candidate for assessor.
