

## ASKS \$5,025 DAMAGES FOR LOSS OF TWO FINGERS

Axel Anderson wants the Duluth Iron & Metal company to pay him \$5,025 damages for the loss of two fingers from his left hand. In district court yesterday he brought suit against Max Zalk, Hyman Joseph and Louis Zalk, partners, alleging that while in their employment, April 6 this year, a heavy steel plate which he and other workmen were unloading from a car, fell on his hand, severing the second and third fingers. Anderson says he was unacquainted with the danger incident to his work and that the company was negligent in not providing more men to unload the metal.
