

CEMETERY ASSOCIATION ORGANIZED AT EVELETH

EVELETH, Aug. 3.—This city now has a cemetery association and no longer will citizens be compelled to bury their dead at Virginia. The officers are: J. J. Gleason, president; J. C. Poole, vice president; Solomon Sax, treasurer, and Dr. N. C. Bulkley, secretary.

The cemetery site, which consists of about 13 acres, lying a short distance north of the city, is at present the property of the city of Eveleth. The city is now engaged in clearing and levelling the ground, which will also be laid out and fenced. Roads will be graded from the Virginia road to the grounds, also the roads through the grounds.

When this preliminary work is completed, which will be before winter, the property will be deeded over to the association, which will be required to maintain the cemetery without cost to the city.
