

# WANTS \$7,500 BECAUSE ONE LEG IS SHORTER THAN IT SHOULD BE

For a broken leg sustained in a fall on a snow-covered sidewalk, Erick Wallin wants \$7,500 damages from Karl A. Franklin and Edward Kaner. In district court yesterday suit was begun for this sum.

Franklin, as lessee, and Kaner as owner of a store at 1905 West Superior street, neglected to remove the snow and ice from the pavement fronting the store March 16, declares the complaint. As Wallin turned into the building he says he slipped and fell, breaking his leg, which now is shorter than the other.
