

TRIED TO COLLECT WHEAT BILL; HELD ON HOLDUP CHARGE

Because Joe Gdowski tried to collect a bill from Arthur Levinson he was arrested on a charge of attempting to rob and will be held at the police headquarters until municipal court convenes this morning.

Levinson, who lives at 323 Cumming avenue, claims that Gdowski and Joe Kolpson stopped him and his companion, H. Titch, 515 Ogden avenue, between Tower avenue and Ogden avenue on Sixth street, yesterday and asked for money. His plea was so forceful that Levinson called Patrolman Robideaux and the pair were arrested.

When taken to headquarters Gdowski claimed to have sold Levinson some wheat which was swept from boxcars by his wife. Levinson never paid him for the wheat, he says, and he attempted to collect the bill yesterday with dire results. Arthur Levinson, the complaining witness, and H. Titch, his companion, were each released on \$15 bail and will appear against the pair in court this morning.
