

VERIS DENIES GUILT IN SHOOTING DANEIKO; EXAMINATION OCT. 21

Harry Veris, charged with assault in the first degree, the outcome of the shooting of Morris Daneiko Wednesday night in Daneiko's second hand store, 529½ West Michigan street, pleaded not guilty yesterday and his examination will be held at 10 o'clock Oct. 21. Veris claims the shooting was an accident, that occurred when he was buying a revolver from Daneiko.

The police assert that the revolver with which Daneiko was shot was purchased by Veris Monday at the City Loan office, 522 West Superior street. Daneiko, in St. Luke's hospital, is recovering from his wound, it was said last night.
