

AID FOR SUFFERING JEWS IN EUROPE TO BE ASKED IN DULUTH

Representing the Federation of American Zionists, Jacob De Hass of Boston, editor of the Jewish Advocate of that city, will speak Wednesday night at Adas Israel synagogue, Third avenue East and Third street, on "The War and the Jews." The object of his visit and address is to interest Duluth Jews in the movement to relieve suffering of Europeans affected by the war.

Mr. De Hass is well known in Zionist circles. He was secretary to the late Dr. Theodore Herzl, founder of political Zionism. Later he wrote a book on "The Why and Wherefore of Zionism." He has taken an active part in Jewish newspaper work in England and America.
