

ALL PHYSICIANS IN TOWN ARE DRAFTED FOR WAR

EVELETH, Dec. 22.—Solomon Sax, of this city, has received a letter from his parents, who live at Tauroggen, a city on the border between Russia and Germany, in which it is stated that there is not a physician or surgeon in the town. All have been drafted into the army and 10,000 people living there are left without medical attention.

Up to the time the letter was written, Mrs. Sax states the effects of the war, except for the drafting of the doctors, had not been felt there. The letter was many weeks reaching its destination. Since it was mailed the German and Russian armies have been engaged in some fierce fighting along the Russian frontier.
