

GOLDISH CASE DISMISSED FOR LACK OF EVIDENCE

Because the evidence offered by the plaintiffs was insufficient to establish a cause of action, District Judge Dancer, on motion of Attorney John H. Norton, yesterday dismissed the suit of L. Goldish and T. Goldish against the Auto Engine Works. The motion was granted after the plaintiffs had closed their case.

The Goldishes demanded judgment for \$1,852.50 for the alleged failure of the company and its agents to deliver an engine for their motor boat within the time specified by contract. After the suit was begun L. Goldish died. Certain verbal agreements made between him and the company and facts known only to him could not be proved in any other way under the rules of evidence, and the court ordered a dismissal and the jury discharged.
