DEFENDANTS IN DAMAGE SUIT WIN ON DEMURRER Demurrers interposed by Karl A.

Franklin and Edward Kaner to a suit for \$7.500 damages, brought against them by Ezick Wallin in district court, yesterday were sustained by District Judge Cant. The court holds that the complaint does not state facts sufficient to constitute a cause of action against either.

Wallin demanded damages for a broken leg sustained when he fell on an ice-covered sidewalk in front of the Franklin clothing store, 1905 West Superior street, March 16, 1913. Franklin, the lessee of the building.

and Kaner, the owner, were charged with negligence in allowing the sidewalk to be covered with ice and snow over a period prohibited by the city

ordinance.
