

# DOROTHY PATTON TO REPRESENT CENTRAL SCHOOL IN CONTEST

In one of the closest and best preliminary contests ever held, Miss Dorothy Patton was chosen yesterday as declaimer to represent Central high school in the Wallace cup contest at Superior May 8. The subject of her declamation was "The Man In the Shadow."

In averaging their individual awards the judges gave Miss Patton 90 per cent; Emanuel Cook, 80 per cent, and Miss Ruth O'Brien, 89 2-3 per cent. By virtue of exceeding Cook in the ranking of one judge and getting a better average than Miss O'Brien, Miss Patton was given first place.
