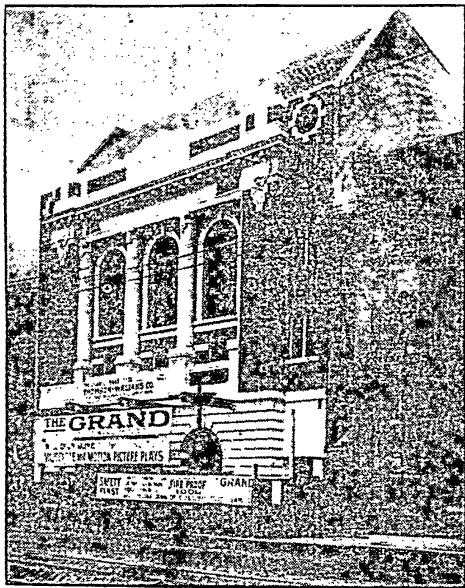


# GRAND, DULUTH'S NEWEST THEATER, IS RAPIDLY NEARING COMPLETION



213-217 WEST SUPERIOR STREET.

With exterior work practically finished, contractors are hurrying the work on the new Grand theater, being built on the site of the old St. James hotel, so that it will be ready for occupancy by June 1. The new amusement house will seat approximately 1,200 persons and will be the largest one of its kind at the head of the lakes, excepting the Orpheum and Lyceum. The seating capacity

of the Orpheum is estimated at 1,500 persons.

Wanganstein & Gilhuson of Duluth, are the architects for the structure and Fawcett & Bergstrom, also of this city, the general contractors in charge of the work. It is being built for Moses S. Cook and will cost, when complete, about \$75,000. Many new features will be embodied in the new amusement house, according to the plans.
