

BUILDING IN CITY SETS RECORD MARK

Residence Permits Totaling \$34,-
500 Issued Yesterday—City
in Midst of Boom.

Superior is experiencing a building boom which has been equaled few times since the birth of the city. During the last month a large number of building permits have been issued by Fire Chief Olaf Johnson and yesterday permits for 12 residences were granted.

These granted permits are: Siegel Brothers, \$2,500 residences at 1701-3-5 Ogden avenue and one at 1613 Eighteenth street; Elias Segal, \$5,000 dwelling at 1610-12 Hughitt avenue; Hans Hagreen, \$2,000 residence at 1909-11 Hughitt avenue; A. Duplaise, \$3,000 dwellings at 1902-4-6-8 Baxter avenue; P. A. McConnville, store and flat building, \$3,500, 1114 Belknap street; and an extension to a residence by Joe Lynch to cost \$2,000 at 1417 Cumming avenue.

More permits are being issued every day than daily for the last few years, according to Chief Johnson.
