

MOTHER LEFT CHILD; NOTES TO HELP IT RETURNED TO MEN

Because Beccy Karon failed to comply with an agreement to care for her child, two promissory notes for \$75 and \$50 issued in her favor by L. Karon and Ben Karon, yesterday were ordered cancelled by District Judge Dancer.

With the understanding that she would provide for her child, the Karons, its father and uncle, signed the notes and delivered them to Mrs. Karon. She placed them in the First National bank for collection, gave her child to a neighbor to look after and then left the city.

The child later was brought to her father's home, and immediately thereafter proceedings were begun to stop payment on the notes. Luckily for Karon brothers, the notes had not been sold to an innocent purchaser, but had been left with the bank for collection. The court issued an injunction restraining the bank from delivering the notes to any person other than the makers.
