

MOSES COOK DEMANDS \$454 FROM MOSES COOK

Declaring that Moses S. Cook violated the terms of a party wall agreement when he removed the buildings on lot 32 West Superior street and erected in their place a larger building, Samuel E. Gittelson and Moses Cook yesterday began suit in district court for \$451.37.

They allege that Moses S. Cook, in tearing down the wall dividing their premises, left water pipes exposed, causing them to freeze, cut electric wiring and otherwise damaged the adjoining property owned by them.
