

RESTRAINING ORDER SERVED AT EVELETH

Mayor, Commissioners and Clerk Stopped in Tax Levy Work.

EVELETH, Sept. 1.—Copies of a restraining order prohibiting them from establishing this year's tax levy at any amount to exceed \$225,000, were filed on Mayor J. J. Gleason, Commissioners J. J. Brince, Michael Langdon, George Mesberg and S. H. Owens and City Clerk A. P. Romer this afternoon. The order was granted by District Judge Hughes in Virginia earlier in the day.

Recently the commissioners announced that a tax levy of between \$360,000 and \$375,000 would be asked shortly. The order was secured by Martin Hull, one of the fee owners of the Leonidas mine and is returnable before Judge Hughes Sept. 10. At this time the officials will be called upon to show cause why the order should not be made permanent.
