

# EVELETH FACES ANOTHER RECALL

**Petitions Circulated to Remove  
Acting Mayor Owens and  
Commissioner.**

**MOTIVE OF REVENGE  
INCENTIVE, IS CHARGE**

**Report That Former Executive Is  
Behind Move Brings  
Forth Denial.**

EVELETH, Sept. 24.—Recall petitions were circulated here today by forces aiming to remove Acting Mayor Sam Owens and Commissioner Mesberg.

Despite the report that 125 signatures had been obtained, it was said by persons in authority that the petitions bore but 30 names at a late hour tonight. Two hundred and sixty-five names are needed in order to make effective a call for a recall election.

According to Eveleth men acquainted with facts in the case, the recall attempt is the result of the economy move instituted by Mayor Owens, who removed four watchmen, several poundmasters and the assistant park commissioner at the last council meeting.

**Allege Revenge Motive.**

That friends of the ejected officials seek to obtain revenge, is a common report.

If a sufficient number of signatures is presented on the petitions, a recall election will be held Oct. 12. Feeling here is quite bitter and appearances indicate that the battle will be a long and stubbornly-contested one.

In certain circles denial was made of a report that the Gleason and Brince supporters have anything to do with the attempt to recall the two officials.

Owens succeeded Mayor Gleason when the latter was recalled in a recent election.

**Primaries Oct. 12.**

At the primaries on Oct. 12 nominations will be made for mayor and one commissioner. It is understood that William Murray will be a candidate for a commissionership. Jacob Saari defeated candidate for mayor at the last election, is expected to enter the field again.
