

# DOUBLE TROUBLE FOR MAN IN CITY COURT

---

**Kohkonen, Fined for Hosiery  
Theft, Held for Grand Jury  
on Larceny Charge.**

Otto Carlson, who was arrested by Detective Schulte Monday, found himself facing two different varieties of larceny charges in municipal court yesterday..

The man was arrested for being the partner of Uno Kohkonen who recently stole a few handkerchiefs from the store of Max Sosnovsky, 109 East Superior street, and was led to police headquarters by the proprietor of the store who pretended to show his customer the "sights." In court yesterday Carlson was charged with having stolen six pair of hose from the store at the same time and received a fine of \$50 or 30 days in the county jail on this count.

After Carlson was arrested his room was searched and property was found which Detective Schulte alleges was stolen from the room of Miss Anna Winkler, 124 West Third street, who is the roommate of Carlson's former wife. With this evidence Carlson was charged also with grand larceny. He waived examination and was held for the grand jury.

It is alleged he stole a diamond ring worth \$75, a gold bracelet, a pocketbook, a safety deposit box receipt and other articles from the room.

Kohkonen, who was Carlson's partner on the shop lifting excursion is serving a 30-day sentence at the work farm.
