

# DECISION POSTPONED IN FEED TEST CASE

After attorneys argued for more than two hours, Judge F. S. Parker Tuesday took the test case against Isadore Dorf and Charles Arinovich under advisement. He will render a decision today.

Dorf and Arinovich, proprietors of a feed store on Seventh street and Ogden avenue, are charged with selling concentrated feed without a state license. Their arrests were obtained through efforts of state inspectors.

The contention of Attorney H. C. Wilson, representing the men, is that the Rugby Milling company, Rugby, N. D., from where the local concern obtained the feed, is licensed and that the local concern need not have a state license for that reason.
