

# FEED DEALERS WIN IN LOCAL TEST CASE

By discharging Isadore Dorf and Charles Arinovich, Judge F. S. Parker of municipal court yesterday decided that retail feed distributors need not obtain state license when manufacturers of the feed had previously obtained license. The action was a test case.

Dorf & Arinovich, proprietors of a feed store at Seventh street and Ogden avenue, had been arrested on charges of selling concentrated feed without a state license. Their arrest was obtained through the services of state agents who came to Superior from Madison.

When the case was tried, it was taken under advisement by Judge Parker and decision was rendered yesterday. Contentions of the defendants that the Rugby Milling company, Rugby, N. D., from which the local concern obtained the feed, is licensed and that Dorf & Arinovich need not be licensed on that account was upheld by the court.
