

AUTO STRIKES BOY; DRIVER SPEEDS AWAY

Severe Bruises While Playing
in Front of Home.**

The driver took one look back and then drove rapidly away. One other passenger, Archie Slegal declared, was in the car.

None of the wheels passed over the boy. Dr. P. G. McGill, who attended him, declared that his bruises are not serious. He has an abrasion on the head and an ugly bruise on his left leg.
