

33 TONS OF HERRING UNLOADED BY GOLDISH

Thirty-three tons of frozen herring, a record cargo for the season, were unloaded early yesterday from the steamer L. Goldish, which returned from Howard's bay with Capt. Edward Haasen in command.

The staunch little vessel has made a number of trips during the season, returning last month with 30 tons of fish. This cargo was believed to be the record catch until yesterday's arrival.
