

ORECKOVSKY BACK FROM B'NAI B'RITH MEETING

Charles D. Oreckovsky, who represented Duluth lodge No. 6, Independent Order of B'nai B'rith, at a meeting held in Chicago last Sunday, returned to Duluth yesterday.

It was decided at the meeting to change the bylaws of the Cleveland Orphan asylum, which is maintained by the order, so that orphans born abroad can be admitted into the institution. Oreckovsky said. At present only American-born children are accepted.

Oreckovsky attended the initiation of 700 candidates into Ramah lodge while in Chicago.
