

VESSEL OF FROZEN FISH ARRIVES IN PORT WITH 27 TONS ON BOARD

The steamer L. Goldish of the Lake Superior Fish company arrived in Duluth from Grand Marais yesterday with 27 tons of frozen herring aboard. The fish were caught in Lake Superior. The crew of the ship reported that the ice of the lake was broken nicely and that weather was excellent for sailing.

Sam Goldish of the Lake Superior Fish company declared yesterday that his concern would start winter fishing under the ice as soon as Lake Superior freezes over. About 75 men are employed by the company in fishing under ice during the winter months, Goldish said.
