

WILL PRESENT PLAY IN HANNUKAH PAGEANT

Public Invited to Hear Program
at Adas Israel Synagogue
Tonight.

The play which Rabbi W. Kissin, director of the Moses Montefiore Jewish school, arranged as part of the program for the celebration of Hannukah; the feast of dedication, which ends next Thursday, will be given tonight at Adas Israel synagogue, Third avenue East and Third street.

Three little girls present the introductory phase, emphasizing that the festival of Hannukah commemorates the efforts of the Maccabees in preserving the Jewish race, rather than singing the praises of victorious warriors of bloody battlefields.

Following the impressive ceremonial of kindling the lights seven children, each representing a holiday and one emblematic of the congregation, engage in a series of dialogues and tableaux in which the significance of the Jewish feast is explained.

The climax is reached in a graphic description of the trials of the Jewish war sufferers in stricken Europe.

The program will start at 7 o'clock and everybody is invited. There will be no admission charge.
