

NOMINEES FOR COMMERCIAL CLUB OFFICERS CHOSEN

Eveleth Civic Organization Will Get New Lease on Life. Plan Campaign.

EVELETH, April 3.—The nominating committee of the Eveleth Commercial club which was re-organized this week met today and selected nominees for the club officers to be voted on May 5 at the annual meeting.

C. H. Hoel and Charles Grabowsky were selected as candidates for the presidency; John Manthey and G. A. Whitman for first vice president; Victor Essling and J. A. Quinn, second vice president; Will Davey and W. H. Harvey, treasurer; Sam Ellis, W. R. Van Slyke, J. C. Poole, Dr. J. G. Saam, Joe Wilson, George E. McCormick, C. Mather, E. J. Kane, Edward Helps, Attorney Frost, J. J. Giblin and Jacob Saari, directors.

The new bylaws provide that two nominees be provided at least 30 days before election for each office by the committee. Any five members may propose a third set of nominees. The nominating committee was D. W. Freeman, C. H. Barnes, J. A. Raab, W. J. Davey and Sam Ellis.

D. C. McIntyre is chairman and Sidney Kaye, secretary of the temporary organization. The board of directors will hire a paid secretary. C. B. Hoel is chairman of the committee which will ask the city council for financial aid. The club membership is now 50 but one of the first steps in the program of the new organization will be a membership campaign.

The club will meet on the first Monday of every month. The annual meeting will be in May. It is planned to incorporate the organization.
