

# INJURED LAD IS MADE HAPPY BY 'ZIONIST' FLOWERS

Lying on a cot in St. Luke's hospital, little "Jack" Polinsky, whose life was despaired of after he had been struck by a jitney, was made happy yesterday when he looked through tear-dimmed eyes on a vase of flowers. They were the gift of a patron of the Zionists' flower day sale conducted in Duluth and Superior Sunday and yesterday.

So happy was little "Jack" when the nurse brought the vase into his room that he was overcome as he sought vainly to express his thanks. It was the first attention he had received from an outsider since he was injured last Wednesday morning.

"Jack" is the 12-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Sam Polinsky, 928 Fourth avenue East. Hospital attendants believe he will recover.

The flower sale of the Zionists was handicapped by the unfavorable weather. A number of young Jewish women obtained telephone orders in Duluth and Superior and their sales will net \$30.
