

9 TO GRADUATE UNDER NEW RULE

**Results From Experiment in Superior High School Shown
by List of Graduates.**

**WERE GIVEN FREEDOM
IN SELECTING STUDIES**

**Entire Class Will Total Eighty-
Five, One of Largest in
School's History.**

Results from the experimental "general" course offered Superior high school pupils last February by Principal C. G. Wade as a means of earning a diploma without taking required subjects appeared with the compilation of the 1915 June list of graduates. Nine of the seniors will finish under the "general" course.

The course gives the pupils complete freedom in choosing their studies. Only 30 credits for work offered under any of the other school courses are required. The diploma is acceptable as signifying graduation from a high school but should one holding such a "sheepskin" desire to enter college, the college studies must be conformed to.
